We are also grateful you are willing to dispose of hospital beds in storage at Eager Beaver and eliminating that yearly charge of \$200.00. I am enclosing a copy of the press release explaining to the public what our intentions are.

Enclosed is a Cashiers Check for \$2414.76 and \$16.00 cash, the balance of our bank account. It is our understanding that you will set up a fund to be used in the future for services that we would normally have provided with this money. We also understand that if persons wish to contribute to that fund it will be used for patient care also. One of our functions was to aid clients that had to make frequent trips to the mainland for medical purposes. We hope that this might continue when needed.

There are members of the former Helping Hands that would be willing to assist clients in the future and work with you to make that possible. They are: Andy Kohls, Sandy LoDico, Loretta Slater and Linda Wern.

We discussed the possibility of an annual report and hope that it might be possible so we might be kept informed. It was a pleasure to serve so many in this community in the 21 years we were in existence.
